Surface abrasion resistance classification of the glazed ceramics is determined by using P.E.I. method in accordance with Turkish and International standards.

- **PEI I** Ceramic tile can be used on grounds where there are no abrasive materials and where one will walk barefoot or with soft-sole shoes.
- **PEI II** Ceramic tile can be used on grounds where there are occasionally small amount of abrasive materials and where one will walk with soft-sole or normal sole shoes.
- **PEI III** Ceramic tile can be used on grounds where there are small amount of abrasive materials and where one will walk with normal-sole shoes.
- **PEI IV** Ceramic tile can be used on grounds where there are abrasive materials and which have a heavy pedestrian traffic.
- **PEI V** Ceramic tile can be used on grounds where there are abundant abrasive materials and which have a heavy pedestrian traffic.
